### **JOB GOALS:**

To develop and coordinate educational media services and assist teachers and students in the effective use of the media center and information technology as a learning resource to support the school's curriculum and to develop students' information literacy skills.

## **PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Selects, organizes, and supervises the execution, use, or conduct of printed, non-printed and on line resources and subscription materials appropriate to the curriculum and individual's needs.
- 2. Prepares annual budget request for funds.
- 3. Accounts for all media center materials.
- 4. Plans for effective utilization of physical facilities.
- 5. Develops short and long-range goals for the media center program.
- 6. Supervises the work of the media center staff.

- 7. Participates in the coordination of support library/media staff.
- 8. Communicates information regarding media programs and resources to the school community.
- 9. Provides reading, viewing, and research guidance for individuals and/or groups.
- 10. Assists and instructs students and faculty in the use of media center resources as required.
- 11. Works with teachers in planning instructional units and selecting appropriate materials.
- 12. Remains current and uses technology as appropriate.
- 13. Performs other duties within the scope of employment as assigned.
